## Acupuncture

This course instructs the participant in acupuncture point protocols to match the core archetypical formulas of the Shang Han Lun. These very protocols have been developed by Dr. Versluys and have been effectively used in clinic for many years, thus demonstrating a solid track record. Upon completion, the participant will have mastered a methodology to translate or extrapolate any classical herbal formula into an acupuncture and moxibustion prescription, thus allowing for greater consistency in clinic, increased efficacy and full herb-needle integration.

## Pulse Diagnosis

In this lecture, Dr. Versluys will be building on the basic pulse instructions of the Shang Han Lun weekend taught in March 2009. This course will introduce to the students the archetypical pulse patterns for the most commonly used prescriptions of the six conformations of the Shang Han Lun. This material is unique and not to be found anywhere since it is a part of the Tian-Zeng lineage to which Dr. Versluys belongs. This is truly an advanced course in pulse diagnosis that is crucial to bring the practice of the Shang Han Lun formulas to life.

He is the founder and director of the Institute of Classics in East Asian Medicine ([www.iceam.org](http://www.iceam.org)) which offers postgraduate training in classical Chinese Medicine worldwide.
